Michael Pell, Kira Visser, and Amy Knuver helped the quiz bowl squad to defeat Class B division champion Manistee 270-220 in the morning and then helped our team to outscore Class A division champion Midland High School 290-200 in the afternoon to win the grand championship for the 2009-2010 quiz bowl season.

Out of the 40 schools that took part this season, our team was the only undefeated contingent on television. Also, we have now won back-to-back grand championships on WCMU's Quiz Central and are the only squad in C.M.U. television history to have done so. As a result, our players will be featured in a special PBS television documentary for the second year in a row that will be filmed later this spring.
