The Providence Christian boys basketball team is above the 500 mark with a record of 6-5. They beat Holland Black River this, past Friday night in double overtime by a score of 75-70. This years team has been very exciting to watch. PC lost 3 early season games and 2 of those were to much bigger schools. They have played well together with only 2 losses since the Christmas break. The Storm have 3 players averaging in double figures and one more really close. Out of those 4 players none of them are seniors. That's right the Storm is starting 3 sophomores, a junior, and one senior. Providence Christian only has 7 boys on the varsity team. Its 2 seniors Chance Ouwinga and Michael Clapp and providing good leadership and each doing their role to lead the team. Junior Carl Miller has really stepped it up both offensively and defensively. Carl, at 5'10, usually has the job of guarding the bigger centers of the opposing teams. He has to give up anywhere from 8 to 10 inches and using his strength he has had games like this past week where he brought down 7 and 10 boards and scored 12 and 13 points respectively. Sophomores Luke VanBoxel, Corey Sokolowski, and Dan Geeting are the 3 players scoring in double figures. The three of them have such good court awareness and the ability to score that together they are making each other successful. Freshman Mahlon Volz has really stepped up this season with some really pesky defense. Volz has found his role, by being very athletic, with the team usually given the responsibility of guarding the opposing teams

leading scorer. He is a rebounder as well and understands what the teams needs from him. If you want to really see some good basketball by some really fine young men come watch Providence Christian. They play with huge hearts, great sportsmanship and God's will.
